National Athletic Final Successes

Yateley Manor was represented by four athletes at the National Athletics Finals held at the Pingles Stadium: **Hope Horne** (U14 Javelin), **Michelle Adeola** and **Charlie Everest** (U12 100m) and **Matilda Upfold** (U12 Javelin). All four qualified following superb performances at Senior Wessex.

Hope competed first up and opened with a very good throw of 21.38m. This turned out to be her best throw and earnt her seventh place in a very strong competition. A great achievement.

Michelle and **Charlie** finished second and third respectively in their heats which qualified both for the finals. **Michelle's** excellent time of 14.07 seconds was close to her own school record and **Charlie** ran a super-fast new PB of 13.89 seconds. Both finals were very close with less than a second separating first and eighth places. **Charlie** ran a great race and finished in an excellent seventh place. **Michelle** had a much better start in the final and ran brilliantly to take the bronze medal, a superb performance.

Matilda was the last Yateley Manor athlete to compete and she threw consistently over all four rounds. Her best throw of 16.74m gave her eighth place overall. Another great result.

Many congratulations to all four athletes on tremendous results.
