Thank you also to all the parents who so generously donated a voucher or a cheque for the



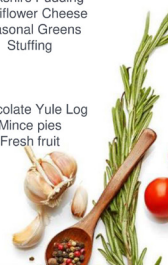
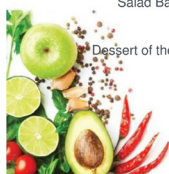
Salvation Army. We know that both donations and chocolates will give a lot of children a happier Christmas than they might otherwise have had.
