Year 2 Fire of London

Children in Year 2 have been studying the Great Fire of London in class. They made models of houses and then spent some time in the Woodland Learning Area watching how the fire spread. Hands-on learning at its very best!



A Taste of Things to Come

Last week, children in Year 6 were treated to a snapshot of what life is like at Yateley Manor in Years 7 and 8. They joined children currently in the senior years and took part in various lessons including:

French cookery - Children had to follow a French recipe and asking for ingredients in French to make Croque Monsieur.

Science - Testing out their scientific skills to extract DNA from a strawberry and make DNA origami.

History - Putting on their detective hats to investigate the causes of cholera; using John Snow's real life data about the epidemic in Soho, London, children were tasked to plot the data on historical maps and use evidence to explain why Elizabeth Abelson died.

Computing - Creating a coding programme to link up to a temperature probe and learning how to make burgers from scratch, using their temperature probes to check they were fully cooked.

Maths - Working collaboratively to solve some mysteries including: The Underground Blackout Theft, The Mystery of Cinema Suspects, The Contaminated Chocolate and Robbery at the Valentine's Day Disco.

The children in Year 6 had a wonderful day finding out how engaging and inspiring the curriculum in Years 7 and 8 is.

"You are given more responsibility and it feels more of a community"




"You get more freedom and get treated more as an adult"
