Session Considerations

- There is a minimum booking commitment for all children aged 2 to 5 years of 2 full days (full time pupils) or 3 full days (term time pupils). Bookings must be for the same session(s) each week and appropriate notice must be provided for any changes.
- For Full Time bookings, the 2.5 sessions equate to either 5 mornings or 5 afternoons per week.
- Where N/A is noted, this day structure is not offered.
- Full Time fees are calculated evenly over a 51-week year and Term Time fees are calculated over a 34 week year and reflect an adjustment for bank holiday days and the period between Christmas and New Year, when the nursery is not open.
- For Term Time additional sessions may be added subject to availability. Requests for holiday sessions should be made to the Nursery Manager at the earliest opportunity. If there are places available, they will be offered on a first come, first requested basis. The day fee will then be charged for session booked.
- Terms and Conditions applicable to nursery are contain in the School Terms and Conditions document.
- Lunch and snacks are provided throughout the year and included in the fees. All provision of nappies, wipes etc is included within the fees.
- Fees for nursery are continually reviewed and any changes will be publicised with a term's notice before implementation.
- A late charge of £10.00 per 15 mins will apply for any persistent late collections after discussion with the Nursery Manager.
- *Little Lodge will be accepting children from age 9 months from January 2025.

Early Education Funding

- Little Lodge participates in the government Early Years Education Funding (EYEF). This entitles all children aged 3-5 years to a standard 15 hours of funded provision. Children become entitled to funding from the term following their 3rd birthday until the term during their 5th birthday. Little Lodge also offers the extended 15 hours to eligible parents making 30 hours of EYEF available.
- Little Lodge also participates in the EYEF scheme of 15 hours per week for eligible parents of 2-year-old children.
- Little Lodge will participate in the EYEF scheme of 15 hours per week for eligible parents of children 9 months to 2 years from January 2025.
- Fees are chargeable for the hours beyond 15/30 hours EYEF and the funding is deducted prior to the invoice being received.
- Parents are invoiced termly in advance for term time fees and monthly in advance for full time fees. Both sets of fees are payable in advance. Parents must have completed an EYEF form for each term or the EYEF will not be deducted from the fee.
